



Current Visitor Restrictions

IMPORTANT: No one under 18 will be permitted to visit. All visitors will be screened at the front entrance for COVID symptoms, will have their temperature checked and will be provided a mask, which they are required to wear for the duration of the visit. If symptoms or an elevated temperature are present, entrance will not be permitted. Unique cases may be reviewed on a case by case basis.

Acute Care

A patient who is staying overnight may have one visitor at a time for non COVID + patients.

COVID + patients will be allowed 1 visitor/support person. They must be the same person for the duration of the stay and follow PPE protocols as directed.

Exceptions:

1. Minors may have both parents or guardians.
2. Patients who are at the end of life may have additional visitors, if approved by the floor supervisor.

Emergency Department

ONE visitor/support person is allowed per general ER patient.

- Visitor must remain in the room with the patient through the entire visit.
- All trauma and code patients will not be allowed visitor/support person due to aerosolizing procedures taking place with these patients.
- CoVID + or suspected CoVID+ patients will not be allowed visitors due to infection control issues.
- Patients who are at the end of life may have two visitors if approved by ER staff.

Surgical Services

ONE visitor/support person is allowed per elective surgery patient.

This person will either be asked to come back when surgery is complete or will be able to wait in Outpatient room if available. – Will review on a case by case basis.

Exceptions:

1. Minors may have both parents or guardians.

OB

OB patients may have one visitor/support person at a time for non COVID + patients.

COVID + patients will be allowed 1 visitor/support person. They must be the same person for the duration of the stay and follow PPE protocols as directed.

Clinic and Other Outpatient Areas (Lab, Radiology, Rehab)

ONE visitor/support person is allowed per patient.

Exceptions:

1. Minors may have both parents or guardians.
