Cancer Center



Where will the Cancer Center be located?

The Cancer Center will be on the east side of the CMMC campus, located in the horseshoe shaped area where the old Emergency Room was once located. The addition will fit into that space almost like a puzzle piece. The front will have a distinguished roof line and will have two floors in height. The two-story design, drive through drop off and architecture planned will provide a pristine entrance to the medical center.

How will operating costs be funded?

The new Cancer Center will be self-sustaining with services and programs provided that cover the cost of operations and patient care.

Who are the engineers & architect working on the project?

Cushing Terrell are both the engineers and architects. They have designed several cancer centers including Billings Clinic's.

What does the bid process look like?

The project will go out to bid in spring of 2023.

How will contractors be decided?

Selection criteria will include contractor capacity, experience in health care, interview results, and price.

With current workforce challenges, what does this look like in staffing the Cancer Center?

CMMC is uniquely positioned to recruit staff for the Cancer Center due to the strategic location of Lewistown and the quality-of-life central Montana has to offer. Although in general oncology professionals live in larger communities – where the majority of Cancer Centers are located – Central Montana offers an opportunity to experience and live in a rural environment that is conducive to outdoors activities and raising a family.
